General FAQ's

WHO IS LEARNING VAULT?

WHY HAVE I RECEIVED AN EMAIL FROM LEARNING VAULT?

If you've received a digital credential, it means you've earned a course credential, certification, demonstrated skill or professional achievement in your field or industry from the issuing organisation.

Now you have your digital credential, you can now easily showcase your skills and accomplishments to potential employers or peers.

WHAT IS A DIGITAL CREDENTIAL?

A digital credential is a virtual, secure asset issued to validate an earned course credential, certification, demonstrated skill or professional achievement. It can be displayed on digital platforms such as social media profiles, resume, or personal websites to showcase your accomplishment to potential employers or peers.

By earning and using digital credentials, you can demonstrate your skills and achievements in a more portable and credible way, helping you stand out in competitive job markets.

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES OF HAVING A DIGITAL CREDENTIAL?

Digital credentials can be shared easily across a variety of platforms, such as social media, personal websites, and professional networking sites. This makes it easier for you to showcase your skills and accomplishments to potential employers, colleagues, and peers.

As well as this, your digital credentials are stored in your digital backpack, meaning they can be accessed from anywhere with an internet connection. This makes it easy for you to access your achievements as you move from job to job or pursue new opportunities.

WHAT IS THE PROCESS FOR DETERMINING IF I HAVE EARNED A CREDENTIAL?

Upon earning a credential, you can expect to receive an email notification from Learning Vault (noreply@learningvault.io). This email will provide you with detailed instructions on how to claim your digital credential and set up your digital backpack.

Accessing your credentials

WHAT STEPS DO I HAVE TO TAKE TO ACCESS MY CREDENTIAL?

- 1. Check your email: You may have received an email notification with instructions on how to access your digital credential. Look for an email from <u>noreply@learningvault.io</u> which will contain a link to the digital credential platform and provide prompts to create an account. If this can't be located, please check your spam or junk folder before contacting us at <u>support@learningvault.com.au</u>
- 2. Create an account: If you don't have an account on the digital credential platform, you will need to create one. Follow the link provided in the email or by referring to the video links found on our <u>YouTube</u> channel to create an account.
- **3.** *Log in:* Once you have created an account, log in to our digital credential platform using your credentials.
- 4. Locate your credential on the platform.
- **5.** *Download or share your credential:* Depending on the platform you wish to share this to; you may be able to download a digital image of your credential or share it directly from the platform to social media or other digital channels.

WHAT STEPS CAN I TAKE TO ENSURE THAT I RECEIVE THE EMAIL NOTIFICATION FOR MY DIGITAL CREDENTIAL?

To ensure that you receive your credential notification email and prevent it from being flagged as spam, consider adding noreply@learningvault.io as a Contact or Safe Sender in your email settings. The process for adding a new contact may vary depending on your email provider, so you should consult your email provider's instructions on how to do this.

If your email address is associated with a work network, you can also contact your network administrator and request that they whitelist the email address **noreply@learningvault.io**. This should help ensure that your credential notification email is delivered to your inbox.

ARE YOU HAVING TROUBLE RECEIVING AN EMAIL TO RESET YOUR PASSWORD?

There could be a few reasons why you haven't received a password reset email. One possibility is that the email has been sent to your spam or junk folder, or it may have been blocked by a network firewall. Another possibility is that you are trying to generate a password reset email for an email address that is not registered as your primary or confirmed secondary email address.

I HAVE MULTIPLE PROFILES, AM I ABLE TO MERGE THESE?

To effectively consolidate all your credentials in one place, it is recommended that you ensure all of your credentials are linked to the same email address.

I HAVE ACCESSED MY DIGITAL BACKPACK, BUT I CANNOT VIEW MY CREDENTIALS.

To resolve this issue, make sure that the email address you use to log in to learningvault.io is the same as the email address to which your digital credential delivery email was sent. If you log in with an email address that does not have any credentials associated with it, you will create a new digital backpack that does not contain any credentials.

Alternatively, if you have not received your credential, we recommend that you reach out to your credential issuer for assistance. They can either resend your credential or provide an update on the status of issuing your credential.

WHAT OCCURS WHEN MY CREDENTIALS REACH THEIR EXPIRATION DATE?

To effectively consolidate all your credentials in one place, it is recommended that you ensure all of your credentials are linked to the same email address.

CAN A POTENTIAL EMPLOYER OR RECIPIENT I HAVE SHARED MY DIGITAL CREDENTIAL WITH VERIFY IT?

Verifying the authenticity of a digital credential is essential to ensure that it is valid and not fraudulent. To verify a digital credential, you can follow these steps:

- **1.** Click on the digital credential that was issued to you.
- 2. Click on the "Verify Badge" button.
- **3.** This will open a verification page that confirms the validity of the badge information.

The information that is included in the verification page may vary, but it typically includes:

- Issued By (the organisation that issued the credential)
- Issued To (your name or the name of the person who earned the credential)
- Expires On (if applicable)
- Issued On (the date the credential was issued)

You can use this information to confirm the validity of the digital credential and ensure that it was issued by a reputable organisation.

WHERE CAN I GET ASSISTANCE WITH ANY INQUIRIES REGARDING MY DIGITAL BADGE?

If you have a question or concern regarding your digital badge, such as incorrect information or an issue with the image, you should reach out directly to the badge issuer. WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS WHEN BUILDING A GRAPHIC FOR A DIGITAL CREDENTIAL?

Using an appropriate size for your certificate background image is crucial in ensuring a high-quality certificate. If the image is too small, it may appear blurry or pixelated. Our recommended minimum size for the certificate background image is 600 x 600 pixels and it should be saved in either PNG or JPEG format.

HOW DO I LOGIN TO LEARNING VAULT AS AN ISSUER?

As an issuer of credentials with Learning Vault, you can log in to your account by visiting the learningvault.io website and entering the email address associated with your account. Once you have logged in, you will have access to your dashboard where you can create, publish, and issue your digital credentials to recipients.

Sharing your digital credentials

WHAT IS THE PROCESS FOR SHARING MY DIGITAL CREDENTIAL?

A significant advantage of digital credentials is their portablility - you can easily share your achievements with friends, customers, and prospective employers.

To share your digital credential, you can make use of the unique URL associated with it. This URL can be shared through various online and social media channels and is the most effective means of sharing your credential with others.

HOW CAN I SHARE MY DIGITAL CREDENTIALS ON MY LINKEDIN FEED?

- **1.** Log in to your learningvault.io account.
- **2.** Navigate to your digital backpack and select the digital credential you want to share.
- **3.** Click on the "Share Badge" button on the reverse side of the credential.
- **4.** Choose the LinkedIn icon and log in to your LinkedIn account if prompted.
- **5.** Select the option to share your digital credential as a post or send it as a private message to your LinkedIn connections.
- **6.** Alternatively, select the "*View Badge*" option to access the webpage for your digital credential.
- 7. Click on the LinkedIn icon on the credential's webpage to share it in multiple ways.
- **8.** Choose to share your digital credential as a post, send it as a private message, or both.
- **9.** Finally, click on the "*Share URL*" button and copy the link to your digital credential's webpage.
- **10.** Paste the link directly into the post section of your LinkedIn news feed.
- **11.** Your digital credential is now shared on LinkedIn and visible to your professional network.





HOW CAN I SHARE MY DIGITAL CREDENTIALS TO MY LINKEDIN PROFILE?

To add your digital credential to your LinkedIn profile, follow these steps:

- **1.** Log in to your learningvault.io account.
- **3.** Click on the flip badge arrow to see the reverse side of the credential.
- 4. Select the "Share Badge" button to reveal multiple ways to share your credential.
- **5.** Copy the credential URL link.
- **6.** Log in to your LinkedIn account.
- **7.** Go to your personal profile page and check if you have a "*Licenses and Certifications*" section.
- 8. If you do not have the "*Licenses and Certifications*" section, click on "*Add Profile Section*" and select "*Licenses and Certifications*" option.
- **9.** Fill out the name of the activity, the name of the organisation that issued the credential, the date when you were issued the credential, whether the credential expires or not, and the credential URL.
- **10.** Click on the "Save" button.
- **11.** Check that the credential has displayed correctly on your profile and click on the "See Badge" option to ensure that the link is working properly and will take your LinkedIn connections to the correct webpage.

That's it! You have successfully added your digital credential to your LinkedIn profile page.

CAN I SHARE MY DIGITAL CREDENTIALS TO FACEBOOK?

Yes, you can share your digital credentials on Facebook. Here are the steps to follow:

- **1.** Log in to your learningvault.io account.
- **2.** From the main page of your digital backpack, select the digital credential you want to share on Facebook.
- **3.** Click on the flip badge arrow to see the reverse side of the credential.
- 4. Select the "Share" icon to view multiple ways to share your credential.
- 5. Select the Facebook icon and log in to your Facebook account.
- **6.** Choose whether you want to share the credential to your newsfeed, story, or both.
- **7.** Alternatively, select the "*View Badge*" option to see the webpage that your audience will see when sharing.
- **8.** On this page, you can share your credential to over 100 social media platforms, including Facebook. Click on the Facebook icon and choose whether you want to share to your newsfeed, story, or both.
- **9.** Another way to share your credential is by clicking the "*Share URL*" button and copying the link to your Facebook timeline's status bar.
- **10.** Once you've selected your preferred sharing method, follow the prompts to share your credential on Facebook.

That's it! You should now be able to share your digital credential on Facebook.

HOW TO DISPLAY YOUR DIGITAL CREDENTIAL IN YOUR EMAIL SIGNATURE

Yes, you can display your digital credentials in your email signature. Here's how to do it:

- **1.** Log in to your learningvault.io account.
- 2. Select the digital credential you want to display in your email signature.
- **3.** Click on the flip Badge arrow to see the reverse side of the credential.
- 4. Select the "Share Badge" button and choose the email icon.
- 5. Enter your email address and click on the "Send" button.
- **6.** Check your email inbox for an email from LearningVault with the subject *"LearningVault Credential Email Signature."*
- **7.** Follow the instructions in the email to copy the credential HTML code.
- **8.** Open your email signature settings in your email client.
- **9.** Paste the credential HTML code into your email signature.
- **10.** Save your changes and send a test email to ensure that your credential is displaying correctly.

- 7. Click the "Credential" button to ensure that you have linked the correct credential.
- **8.** Alternatively, select the "*View Badge*" option on the credential you want to share and click the "*Share URL*" button to get the credential URL link.
- **9.** Copy the link and paste it as a new link on your Linktree profile.
- **10.** Repeat the process for all your credentials and add them to your Linktree account.
- **11.** Use your Linktree URL to share the collection of your credentials anywhere online.

HOW TO SHARE YOUR BADGE TO INSTAGRAM

Here are the steps to follow to share your digital credential from LearningVault to Facebook Workplace:

- **1.** Log in to your LearningVault.io account from your mobile device.
- 2. Navigate to your digital badge and click on the "Share Badge" button.
- 3. Choose the Instagram icon and select "Share on Instagram".
- 4. Select the image you want to share on Instagram and click "Next".
- 5. Add a caption to your image and any desired hashtags, and then click "Share".
- **6.** Alternatively, you can download an image of the badge by selecting the *"Download Badge"* option and then upload it to Instagram as a regular post or story.

To include a link to your digital credential in your Instagram profile, paste the credential URL into your profile bio or use a third-party service like Linktree to create a landing page with links to your credentials.
